This is as a result of the success of the Murrabit Township Centenary back in October 2024 and the fabulous heritage themed displays set up in the Murrabit Hall for the weekend. While the old church can't fit the same quantity as the hall, the pop up display will nevertheless engage residents and visitors in the interesting history of Murrabit and district. It will be open from 9:30am to 12 noon while the Murrabit Market is running so pop in if you have time. Gold coin donation. It is hoped that the pop-up displays will become a regular occurrence over the coming months.

Coinciding with Good Friday and Easter Saturday is the 78th Annual Murrabit Easter Tennis Tournament. Another great local event which attracts players from all over the place. 

#### MYALL 110<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY INVITATION

Three significant events mark the year 1915 in Myall's history.

On 5 April 1915 Myall Picnic Party crossed the dry bed of the Murray river with horses and buggies for a picnic and games over in the Little Murray.

We celebrate the resilience of the farmers and village settlers of the Myall district in tough times due to the 1914-1915 drought when the rivers ran dry. At this time we also remember the families whose sons had left with the Australian Expeditionary Force for the World War I.

On 21 May 1915 it is recorded that the drought had broken when in 86 hours 197 points (c 49ml) of rain was recorded. With continuing showers it was anticipated that over two inches would fall and the grass would quickly establish and save the many thousands of stock on the verge of starvation.

On 24 May 1915, Empire Day, a new school building was officially opened at Myall. The Myall school which closed in 1993 is now situated in Koondrook, and is the home of the Koondrook Barham Historical Society. The school building continues with the support of a willing band of volunteers to serve our communities.

**3pm** Finale and Afternoon tea at Koondrook (please bring a plate if you are able to).



We played at Northaven for our April performance. We added a little extra with a visit for the residents from our very own HumnStrum Easter Bunny!


Next month we will be returning to Cohuna Village for the first time this year. We are looking forward to it as they were a great audience at our last visit.

A HumnStrum session was held in the hall a couple of weeks back and the group was thrilled they were able to play in the Hall with our shiny new floor!


