

The Murrabit Cod Challenge recently released approximately 6,500 Murray Cod Fingerlings and 4,000 Golden Perch Fingerlings at the Murrabit boat ramp.

This was funded by Murrabit Cod Challenge/ Murrabit Football-Netball Club in conjunction with grant funding from the New South Wales Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development Fisheries Grant Program.

The release all went well with help from local fishing guru Neil "Hoppy" Hopkins who assisted the release.

Thanks to Leigh from Tara Hatcheries for his assistance growing the fingerlings and delivering them, he was very accommodating throughout the process.

We see this being a benefit to the town and our fishing competition into the future, we will look at securing some more funding next year to see our part of the river thriving with fish.

They moved to Bendigo for health reasons, but at his funeral his family mentioned that he loved his time at Murrabit and was the happiest they had ever seen him.

The children were placed in levels, based on ability, and it was great to see the improvement of all swimmers, from those who grew in water confidence through to those who improved their stroke technique and stamina. The Cluster Swimming Sports against Koondrook, Gunbower and Leitchville will occur on Friday 27 February at the Koondrook. Two students competed in the Mallee Zone Swimming Sports, Jade Lavey and Keira McNeil. Both excelled in the 11 years age group, with Jade winning the freestyle and coming 2<sup>nd</sup> in the backstroke. Keira won the breaststroke and came 3<sup>rd</sup> in the freestyle. Both girls were in freestyle and medley relay teams together and won those events. A brilliant effort. They will now compete in the Regional Sports in Swan Hill in March.

On 16 February, we were involved in a program called "Habitat Warriors". This was a hands on program where the students visited the Wirro-lo wetlands at Vistarini Road, Murrabit West. They planted native plants to revegetate sites and maintain plantings. Despite the heat, the children had a fantastic afternoon. Students will monitor this area, with another visit in April and in upcoming years.

### Colour our Town Mural Project

The first workshop occurred last week around the questions:
