Murrabit - Hot Water all round!

The community owned toilet and showers have had a makeover thanks to funding received from the Foundation for Rural and Regional Renewal (FRRR) and Gardiner Foundation.

The funding enabled the aged and unreliable gas hot water service to be replaced with a modern heat pump electric hot water service connected to our existing solar system. Toilet seats and bins were replaced, new signage developed, landscaping completed and lighting installed.

The upgraded facilities improve accessibility, reduce the burden on volunteers, and save on the cost of hot water by connecting to our solar system.

The project forms part of the Murrabit & District Community Plan's climate adaptation priorities, which aim to improve climate and community resilience into the future.


Colour our Town Mural Project

The newest murals are on the front of the Murrabit Market Office/Busy Bees of Murrabit and provide a bright and colourful backdrop to the Murrabit Community Garden. The new murals form stage 4 of a large project from our Murrabit & District Community Plan aimed at injecting colour and vibrancy into our little town and better connecting the town to the Murray River and surrounds.

The little blue wrens are a welcome addition to the colourful murals that grace our town-four cheeky Kookaburras, Eric the wedge tailed eagle, Murray Cod and Murray Cray. Paul's specialisation in native flora and fauna makes him the perfect fit for the project. 


