Developing the 2025 Victorian Transmission Plan

The Victorian Government is currently inviting submissions about the draft Victorian Transmission Plan Guidelines, Feedback is being sought to help:

•shape the method we will use to refine the broad geographical study area to draft proposed renewable energy zones

•identify areas within the study area that we should protect and that would be suitable for renewable energy projects

•identify factors that could influence the placement and design of infrastructure within the study area.

This feedback will be used to shape our approach as we investigate parts of the study area and work through options to identify draft proposed renewable energy zones as part of developing the 2025 Victorian Transmission Plan.

These life saving machines are available to anyone in an emergency.


