Murrabit Community News



This was the first time in 60 years that the P.S. Melbourne had been on our bit of the river, as it makes its way upstream from Mildura to be permanently moored at the Port of Echuca. The P.S, Melbourne was built in Koondrook 112 years ago and has been moored at the Koondrook Wharf for a week or so waiting for river levels to rise to continue its journey.

Lots of pre-1920 vehicles were displayed on the Murrabit Market site while participants, who came from all over Australia, enjoyed a country style morning tea in the Murrabit Public Hall. Make Murrabit Count and Participate in the Regional Wellbeing Survey

The Regional Wellbeing Survey will be launching at the end of October, and Murrabit residents are encouraged to participate.

The annual Survey is run by the University of Canberra and is now in its 13th year.

The survey asks people living outside our big cities to share what's working, and what's not, in their communities.

This year, with funding from the Gardiner Foundation, results from the survey will be used to develop a wellbeing framework and data dashboard for Gannawarra Shire.

Dr Kim Houghton from the University of Canberra is encouraging Murrabit residents to complete the survey, go in the draw to win \$12,000 in prizes, and support donations to neighbourhood houses in Gannawarra Shire.



"The Survey helps us understand what makes your community so special, and what you need to support long-term wellbeing", said Dr Houghton.

"The Survey provides community leaders and organisations with access to local data that can help guide local planning" he said.

As well as the prize draw, completing the survey will also help raise money for Gannawarra's Neighbourhood Houses, as for each of the first 200 surveys completed by Gannawarra residents the University of Canberra will donate \$5 to the Neighbourhood Houses.


